**COMMON ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NOS.19, 29 AND 31 IN RCC**

1. The present application Exhs.19, 29 and 31 filed by accused Nos.1, 3 and 4 for direction to the Regional Passport Authority to issue the passport as per the G.R. issued by the Ministry of External Affairs and Government of India.
2. These application is opposed by the Ld. APP by filing say.
3. It is to be noted that, the accused are charge-sheeted along with other one co-accused for the offence punishable under Section 324, 323, 504, 506 of IPC in the offence bearing crime No.371/2017 registered with City Chowk Police Station, Aurangabad.
4. It is contended that, applicants are in need of the passport for business trip purpose. Therefore, in accordance with the directions of the passport authorities she has moved this application. In support the accuse Nos.1, 3 and 4 assured to be abide by all conditions of this court. The Ld. APP has opposed the application stating that, they will abscond out of the jurisdiction of the court and will not remain present for the trial. Therefore, prayed for rejection of application.
5. Accused are charged for the offence punishable under

section 324, 323, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code. Matter is for evidence. Trial is yet to be completed. Applicant/accused Nos.1, 3 and 4 are permanent resident of the Aurangabad vicinity and considering the nature of offence there is no possibility of absconding. The accused assured that, they shall always be available before this court as and when required. The present application is filed only in respect of issuance of passport. Therefore, no prejudice will be caused if the application is allowed subject to certain conditions. In result I pass the following order.

**ORDER**

- 1] Application Exhs.19, 29 and 31 are allowed.
- 2] The Passport Authority to issue passport to accused/applicant Ayush Sandip Jain, Rakesh Amrutlal Jain and Prashant Dipak Purwar as per Rules.
- 3] The applicants shall not leave India without prior permission of this Court.
