

COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH. 22 & EXH.23

IN SCC No.24242/2024

The State of Maharashtra Vs Prasad Rajendra Sahapurkar

Present applications have been preferred by complainant and prosecution cancellation of bail of accused. It is stated and submitted that, accused is threatening the informant despite the bail condition. So also informant is having apprehension from the accused. Due to the conduct of the accused the informant filed a complaint against him on 21-03-2026 at Jawaharnagar Police Station as accused was threatening her to withdraw the complaint. Therefore she has prayed for cancellation of bail of accused.

2] The accused has filed his say to the present application and Exh.24. He has strongly resisted the present application. He has denied all the allegation. There is no willful disobedience on the part of the accused. HE has not brach any condition of bail granted. Hence he has prayed to reject the application.

3] Perused application, say and record. I have heard Ld. Advocate for both parties at length.

4] Perusal of record shows that accused was granted bail on the condition that he will not prejudice the interest of prosecution, that he will not tamper or threaten prosecution witness. Admittedly the bail was conditional. Record further shows that accused is well aware of those conditions. From complaint filed by the informant it appears that the accused has pressurized the informant to withdraw

the complaint. So also she was threatened and abused in filthy language. Same is apparent on record. Hence application deserves to be allowed. Hence following order:

ORDER

- 1] Bail granted to the accused is hereby cancelled.
- 2] Since accused is absent before the court, issue NBW against the accused.
- 3] Inform the concerned police station.
