ORDER BELOW EXH.1

The present complaint is filed for the offence punishable u/s. 418, 420, 465, 467, 468 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code against the accused persons.

2. It is contentions of the complaint that the accused no.1 and 2 are his brother and sister. Complainant has one other sister also i.e. Leela Prakash More. Their father died in March 2000 and there were agricultural lands of belonging to him at Mategaon, Kannad, Verul etc., the complainant and his other sisters as well as mother were the legal heirs and they have equal right in the property. The accused no.1 and 2 to grab the property of complainants father has filed R.C.S. No.713/2019 and 920/2017 in the court and accused no.1 and 2 have made false power of attorney of complainant and her mother and sister by making false signature of them and filed it in the court and on the basis of it he is filing suit in the court as well as application in various offices. The accused on the basis of false power of attorney might have made many false economic transaction and taken profit out of it and thus the accused have cheated the complainant.

3. The complaint examined himself and her sister Leela

Prakash More as per section 200 of Cr.PC. The complainant has also filed on record copies of power of attorney, certified copy of plaint in RCS no. 920/2017 and 713/2019 as well as complaint filed by him. Perused the verification, documents on record. Heard the learned advocate for the complainant.

4. Perused complaint and verification statement of the complainant and witness. Considering material on record it appears that, there is prima facie material against accused regarding commission of offence punishable u/s. 418,420, 465, 467, 468 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code. Hence, issue summons against accused Nos. 1 and 2, for the offence punishable u/s. 418, 420, 465, 467, 468 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code. Furthermore, case be re-registered as Warrant Trial case.
