**Special Case No.20/2021**  
**The State Vs. Kran Jogilal Rajput**

**Order below Exh.6**  
(Passed on : 21.01.2026)

1. This is application filed by accused ***Karan Jogilal Rajput*** for enlarging him on ***regular bail***, in connection with ***Crime No. 21/2021*** registered at ***Vaijapur*** Police Station u/sec. ***323, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code*** and under section ***3(1)(r)(s) and 3(2)(va)*** of the ***Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.***

2. I have read the grounds mentioned in the application. The Ld. APP opposed the application by filing his say overleaf the application.

3. **Concise story of the prosecution case is as under :-**

Informant lodged report alleging that on 12.01.2021 at about 10.40 p.m. he parked his motorcycle and received phone and talking on phone. At that time accused came and asked him whether road is belongs to his father and assaulted him on hand, elbow, nose, back and said “मांगटयानो तुम्ही खुप माजले आहात, मांगटयानो तुम्हांला दाखवतो” and threatened to kill him. On hearing noise his brother and came and rescued him. Therefore FIR is lodged.

4. The learned APP filed the say overleaf the application and submitted that offence is serious in nature and there is evidence against accused. Lastly it is prayed to reject the application.

5. Say of informant was called. Informant filed his say vide Exh.7 and submitted that he has no objection for enlarging accused on bail.

6. Perused the charge-sheet also gone through the papers on record. It is seen that investigation of crime is over and charge-sheet is filed before the court therefore the physical custody of the accused is not required. The accused is already released on notice under section 41(1)(a) of Cr.P.C. which shows that the custody of accused is not required to IO. Therefore keeping the accused behind bars for uncertain period is not warranted considering the nature of offence. Moreover, the informant has no objection for enlarging accused on bail. Hence, by imposing certain conditions accused is enlarge on bail on following conditions -

### **ORDER**

1. The application Exh.6 is allowed.
2. Accused Karan Jogilal Rajput, be released on bail on his executing P.R. bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rs.Twenty Five Thousand only) with one solvent surety in the like sum on the following conditions -
  - i Accused shall not tamper the prosecution witnesses.
  - ii He shall submit verified copy of her Aadhar Card as well as other address proof along with her mobile number.
  - iii Accused is further directed to submit a list of at least three blood relatives with their detail residential addresses and also the addresses of their place of work with documentary

proof of showing the correctness of the details produced by them.

- iv Accused is also directed that he and his sureties should submit copies of at least two documents amongst their respective Passport, Pan Card, Bank Passbook, Credit Card with photograph, Ration Card, Adhar Card, Electricity Bill, Liberation Serif Landline telephone bill, Voter I.D. Card issued by the Election Commission of India and Property Tax Register while furnishing the bail.
  - v Accused shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner and shall not indulge in any type of criminal activity. If it is noticed that he involved in such type of offence the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation for bail.
  - vi Accused shall not change the place of residence without prior intimation to the concerned police station.
3. Any observation made in this order is made only for limited purpose of deciding this bail application and it shall not come in the way of trial during the trial.
