JUDGMENT

The accused **Kishor Sanjay Gande** appeared before me. The accused is facing prosecution of the offence punishable under Section 279 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

2) He has stated that he wants to plead guilty voluntarily. I explained to him punishment for offence punishable under Section 279 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. I also explained to him that he cannot file appeal against punishment. Still, he maintained his plead. It seems accused voluntarily pleaded guilty. As accused pleaded guilty, it is not necessary to examine witnesses for prosecution. He submitted that he is sole earning member of his family. Considering submissions and nature of accusations and in view of plea of accused. In the interest of justice, I pass following Order :-

ORDER

1.	The accused Kishor Sanjay Gande is hereby convicted for the offence punishable under Section 279 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 vide Section 252 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
2.	The accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.500/- (Rupees five hundred only) in default, the accused shall suffer S.I. for 03 (two) days.
