As per record, the accused persons were apprehended and 2.972 kgs of high quality ganja along with packing material and weighing machine were recovered. During the course of investigation, three days' PC remand of both the accused persons was given to the investigating agency.

Today, it has been submitted by the IO that the associate of the co-accused persons namely Manan Garg had filed his anticipatory bail application before the court and he was directed to join the investigation. It has been apprised that his anticipatory bail application is now listed before the court on 22.04.2025. IO has submitted that Manan Garg joined the investigation on three occasions, however, he did not disclose the complete facts and that

in order to confront the above two accused persons with the third accused person and also in order to trace the other associates and find out the details including source and mode of supply of ganja, two days' PC remand of these two accused persons is required.

Ld. counsel for the accused persons has opposed the application on the ground that the two accused persons are students and one of them, has to appear for his exams beginning 28.04.2025. It has further been submitted that the investigating agency had taken PC remand of both the accused persons and their interrogation report has already been prepared.

Section 187 (3) BNSS states that a Court may authorize detention of the accused persons in police custody even beyond a period of 15 days, if the court is satisfied that adequate grounds exist for doing so. Further, such remand of 15 days can be sought within first 40 days or 60 days depending upon period of sentence. In the instant case, since the offence is punishable with term of imprisonment upto 10 years, the police custody in such cases would be available for upto 15 days within the first 40 days of arrest. The date of arrest of the two accused persons is 16.03.2025.

Having regard to the submissions and in order to facilitate the investigation and also for the purpose of confronting the two accused persons with their associates and also for the purpose of ascertaining the source and mode of supply of ganja, **one day PC remand of both the accused persons namely Abhishek Mishra and Saksham Khera is granted.**

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Both the accused be produced on 22.04.2025.

The bail applications of both the accused persons shall be heard tomorrow i.e. **22.04.2025 at 02:00 PM.**

They be medically examined as per law.
