ORDER BELOW EXH.01

Present application is filed by applicant Nos. 1 to 3 for issuance of Succession Certificate as per Section 372 of Indian Succession Act, 1925.

2. Perused the application and affidavit annexed with the application. Heard learned Advocate Raviraj Shindepatil for applicants.

3. It is the contention of the applicant that the husband of applicant No.1 and father of applicant Nos.2 and 3 viz. Ramdas Eknath Jadhav died on 05.07.2025 at Vaijapur, Tq.Vaijapur. Applicant Nos. 1 to 3 are the only legal heirs of deceased Ramdas Eknath Jadhav.

4. As per applicant, deceased Ramdas Eknath Jadhav has Rs. 5,07,687.84/- savings amount in the bank account No. 009811002003393 of the Aurangabad District Central Co-operative Bank Ltd., Branch Dhondalgaon. As applicant Nos. 1 to 3 are the only legal heirs of deceased Ramdas Eknath Jadhav and for the aforementioned savings amount, they require Succession Certificate. Hence, this application.

5. After institution of this application, Public Notice was issued in the daily newspaper "Marathwada Kesari" dated 31.10.2025 calling upon the public at large to lodge the objections to application, if any. However, till date no one come forward to take objection to this application.

6. In support of this application, applicant filed on record death certificate and Adhar card of deceased Ramdas Eknath Jadhav and Bank pass-book of the Aurangabad District Central Co-operative Bank Ltd., Branch Dhondalgaon. Perusal of death certificate shows that Ramdas Eknath Jadhav has expired on 05.07.2025. Moreover, perusal of bank pass-book of Aurangabad District Central Co-operative Bank Ltd., Branch Dhondalgaon shows that Rs. 5,07,687.84/- in the savings account of deceased. Also, applicant No.3. Parasnath Ramdas Jadhav filed his evidence affidavit (Exh.7). In evidence affidavit (Exh.7), applicant No.3 specifically stated that applicant Nos. 1 to 3 are the only legal heirs of deceased Ramdas Eknath Jadhav and they require Succession Certificate for aforementioned reason.

7. In this application public notice was issued and thereby objections were called from public at large. But no one came forward to take objection. This application is not objected by anyone. Thus, on the basis of contentions made in this application, death certificate and other documents produced on record, prima-facie it reveals that Ramdas Eknath Jadhav has died and applicants are his only legal heirs. As applicant Nos. 1 to 3 are

only heirs to deceased Ramdas Eknath Jadhav, they are entitled to get the amount of Rs. 5,07,687.84/- balance in bank account of deceased i.e. Aurangabad District Central Co-operative Bank Ltd. Branch Dhondalgaon. Hence, issuance of Succession Certificate in the names of applicants is necessary. In view of the above discussion, I find no hurdle to issue Succession Certificate in the names of applicants. Thus, I proceed to pass the following order :-

ORDER

- 1] The application is allowed.
- 2] Issue Succession Certificate in the names of applicant No.1. **Kamalabai urf Kamalbai Ramdas Jadhav**, applicant No.2. **Namdev Ramdas Jadhav** and applicant No.3. **Parasnath Ramdas Jadhav** as legal heirs of deceased Ramdas Eknath Jadhav for receiving the amount of Rs. 5,07,687.84/- from bank account bearing account No. 009811002003393 of Aurangabad District Central Co-operative Bank Ltd., Branch Dhondalgaon.
- 3] Applicants to pay Court fees as per rules.
- 4] Assistant Superintendent to report regarding Court fees.
