Vide order no. Judl.II/F.102/South/Saket/2025/11882-11896 New Delhi dated 05.04.2025 issued by the Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge (South), this court has been authorised u/s 8(8) of the BNSS to dispose of bail / urgent applications pertaining to the police stations / investigating agencies as mentioned in the said order.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant / accused.

Vide this common order, four separate regular bail applications of accused Mohit Jain are disposed off.

Reply to the bail application filed by SI Satbir is already on record.

Arguments heard. Record perused.

Four separate complaint cases for the offence u/s 138 NI Act were pending against the present applicant. As per record, he was not appearing before the Ld. Trial Court and consequently, coercive process was issued against him. As per record, the

applicant was arrested in all the four cases in execution of NBWs issued against him.

Ld. Counsel has submitted that the applicant has no intention to abscond or to cause any delay in proceedings before the Ld. Trial Court. In order to show his bonafide, Ld. Counsel has placed on record, copy of receipt showing payment of Rs. 2,70,000/- to the account of Value Line Interiors Pvt. Ltd., towards interim compensation ordered by the Ld. Trial Court under the provisions of Sec. 143A NI Act. It has been submitted that the applicant undertakes to appear before the Ld. Trial Court on each and every date and shall not seek any unnecessary adjournments.

Having regards to the above submissions and also the fact that the offence u/s 138 NI Act is bailable in nature, **applicant / accused Mohit Jain is admitted to bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 5 lakhs and single cumulative surety of the same amount for the purposes of all the four complaint cases, to the satisfaction of the concerned Ld. JMFC/ Duty JMFC/Link JMFC.**

Application stand disposed of accordingly as allowed.
