**ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

1. The complainant filed this proceeding u/s. 323, 504 and 506 r/w 34 of the IPC against accused.
2. Perused the record. The case is registered on 20/12/2019. The complainant did not take any efforts and absent since long. Hence, on 12/03/2026, matter was kept for dismissal.
3. Thus, in such circumstances, I find it difficult to decide the case on merits and in accordance with the normal procedure contemplated by the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for the considerable time. Hence, I find that there is no propriety in keeping the case pending on the board for years together, without any substantial progress being made. Thus, in this backdrop the following order is passed.

**ORDER**

1. The proceeding of the case is dismissed due to absence of the complainant, under Sec. 256 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973.
2. All accused persons are hereby acquitted of the offence punishable u/s. 323, 504 and 506 r/w 34 of the IPC.
3. The Bail bonds and bonds of the accused be cancelled, if any.
4. Case is disposed off accordingly.
