ORDER BELOW EXH. 1.

This is complaint filed the complainant under sections 504 and 506 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code. However, from the perusal of the record and roznama, it is seen that, complainant and his Ld.advocate are absent though called repeatedly today. It is seen that, complainant and her Ld.advocate are absent since long and failed to proceed with the complaint effectively though the sufficient time and opportunity is granted to him.

2. The present complaint is 6 years old and ineffective. Considering the direction given by the Hon'ble High Court regarding preferably dispose off the old pending matters as per action plan. Perused the roznama it reveals that, dated 24.12.2025 complainant has directed that, she has to taken proper steps toward proceed with the complaint otherwise adverse order has been passed against his. Perused the roznama it appears that, the complainant is not interested in proceeding with the matter effectively and the complaint is unreasonably pending due to want of effective proceeding on the part of the complainant. Considering the absence of the complainant today before this Court, the case is liable to be dismissed under Section 256 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. Hence, the order :-

The complaint is dismissed under Section 256 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
