ORDER BELOW EXH.15 IN R.C.S. NO. 226/2025

(Raosaheb Vs. Vitthal)

This is an application for setting-aside No W. S. order passed against Defendant Nos.1, 3, 5 to 12.

2. It is submitted by the defendants that, they are relied on documents which are very material. However, such documents are not received within time. Hence, delay caused to file W.S. Therefore, defendants prayed to set aside No W.S. order passed against defendant Nos.1, 3, 5 to 12.

3. Per contra, plaintiff filed his say at Exh. 17 and submitted that, the application filed by defendants is false and frivolous. He further submitted that, despite of ample opportunity defendants failed to file their say. Plaintiff submitted that, application is not tenable. Hence, he prayed to reject the application with cost.

4. Perused application filed by defendants Nos.1, 3, 5 to 12 and say thereon. It seems that if defendant Nos.1, 3, 5 to 12 are given an opportunity to decide the suit on merit, it will not cause any prejudice to the plaintiff. Hence, in order to bring dispute between parties to an end, it is necessary to set-aside no w.s. order passed against defendants Nos.1, 3, 5 to 12. Hence, the application is to be allowed. Accordingly, I pass the following order :-

ORDER


