**: ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN CIVIL M. A.No.42/2026:  
(Raosaheb Dharme and Ors. Vs. State)**

This is the application for Heirship Certificate as per section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827.

**02.** According to applicants, Anjanabai Mahadu Dharme died on 02.12.2025 at Mouje Bidkin, Tal. Paithan, Dist. Aurangabad. Husband of the deceased namely, Mahadu @ Madurao Bhimaji Dharme died on 14.12.2008 and the mother of deceased namely, Geerjabai Bandu Rodge died long ago. The applicant nos.1 and 2 are sons and applicant no.3 is a married daughter of deceased. Except applicant, deceased Anjanabai Mahadu Dharme has no other legal heirs.

**03.** Applicants are in need of Heirship Certificate for official purpose. Therefore, applicants constrained to file this application and prayed to grant Heirship Certificate in their favour.

**04.** This is the application for Heirship Certificate as per section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827. Worthless to state here that, this certificate confers no right to the property neither over movable nor immovable, but only indicates the person(s) for the time

being, is or are in the legal management thereof, the granting of such certificate shall not finally determine nor injure the rights of any person, and the certificate shall be annulled by this court upon a proof that another person has a preferable right.

**05.** A public notice was issued in daily 'Samna' dated 03.02.2026 calling upon the objections from the public to the claim of the applicants for grant of Heirship Certificate as prayed for. However, nobody turned up before the Court to file any objection.

**06.** In support of their contentions, the applicant no.1 has filed on record his affidavit of examination-in-chief. He has duly affirmed the contents thereof on oath. Applicant has filed on record the original copy of death Certificates of the deceased Anjanabai Mahadu Dharme and husband of the deceased namely, Mahadu @ Madurao Bhimaji Dharme and verified copy of Aadhar Cards of applicant No.1 to 3. Hence, they are the class-I heir of deceased Anjanabai Mahadu Dharme as per schedule of Hindu Succession Act 1956. The claim of applicant for grant of Heirship Certificate has remained unchallenged. Under these circumstances, I do not find any legal impediment in granting Heirship certificate in favor of applicant no. 1 to 3. Therefore, I proceed to pass the following order :

**: ORDER :**

1. Application is partly allowed.
2. It is hereby declared that applicant No.1 Raosaheb Mahadu Dharme, applicant No.2 Demaji Mahadu Dharme and applicant no.3 Parwatabai Laxman Tagre are the formally recognized heirs of deceased Anjanabai Mahadu Dharme . Issue Heirship certificate in favor of the applicant in the form contained in appendix B of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827.
