



**:ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN R.C.S. No. 58/2018:  
Prabhakar Kachru Jagtap Vs. Shankar Kachru Jagtap**

Plaintiff and defendants are present along with their respective Advocates. Plaintiff presented the compromise pursis at Exh.24 stating that he has resolved his dispute with defendants outside the court. The terms and conditions of the compromise pursis were read out to both the parties. They agreed with those terms and conditions. In light of the compromise pursis it appears that both the parties amicably settled the dispute outside the court and plaintiff has no grievance remained against the defendants. Therefore, the present matter needs to be disposed off in light of the compromise pursis. In backdrop of this situation I pass the following order -

**ORDER**

- 1- Suit is compromised as per compromise pursis at Exh. 24
- 2- Decree be drawn up accordingly as per Compromise pursis at Exh.24.
- 3- Compromise pursis at Exh.24 shall form part of the decree.
4. Court fees be refunded as per rules.
5. Proceedings stopped.
