

ORDER BELOW EXH.11 IN RCS NO. 112/2025
(Shaikh Akbar Vs. Nihal Jamil)

The plaintiff has filed this application for granted of status-quo on the ground that the defendants are making constructing on his plot. The defendants have filed their say on this application at Exh. 12 and contended that, their construction was legal and on their land with permission of concern department. Hence prayed to reject the application.

2. Perused the plaint and photographs filed on record, whole plaint and Exh. 5 is silent on the point as to on which side of the suit property, the defendants are making construction, as to on how much area the defendant making construction on his area. Therefore, on vague pleading the status-quo cannot be granted. Moreover, the plaintiff has supplied copy of documents today itself. There is provision to filed written statement within 30 days to defendant. Therefore, I did not find to fit case to grant status-quo. Hence application is rejected.
