

Order below Exh.08 in RCS No.345/2025

Raybhan Vs. Pratap

The present application is filed by the plaintiff on the ground that defendants are trying to create third party interest in the suit property and therefore, they be restrained from creating any third party interest in the suit property. By way of issuing ad-interim injunction against them.

2. Heard learned counsel for plaintiff.

3. Perused the plaint and documents filed on record. Already the order of issuing summons to the defendants has been passed. Moreover this is a suit for declaration that the sale-deeds executed by defendant No.1 in favour of defendant No.2 and 3 is illegal and void, as they have been executed by showing false four boundaries of suit property.

4. Under these circumstances, this is not a fit case to grant ad-interim injunction without hearing other side. Hence application is rejected.
