


ORDER BELOW Exh. 35
IN SCC NO. 291/2018 Shrimati Rajabai Gunajirao Vairal Multi
State Co-op Credit Society Ltd Majalgaon Branch Phulambri Vs.

By this application complainant prayed for adjournment. On the other side Ld. Advocate for accused, and accused are present before court. Ld. Advocate of accused taken strongly objection to grant adjournment. He submitted that, he is ready to take cross examination of complainant.

2. Heard both Ld. Advocates. Perused record and roznama from it seems that, at Exh. 33 and 34, complainant filed application for adjournment, the same were granted by this court. While granting adjournment Exh. 33 this court impose cost of Rs.100/- upon complainant.

3. Reason mentioned in today's application is that, complainant is not feeling well and bed rest advised by doctor. In respect of this reason complainant is not filed any medical certificate along with this application. This is the complaint filed under Section 138 of N. I. Act. As per direction of Hon'ble Apex Court the complaint under section 138 N. I. Act shall dispose off as early as possible. This complaint filed in the year 2018. it is pending for evidence since 5 years. The reason mentioned in application is not satisfactory. But, in the interest of justice fare trial in view of this last adjournment shall be granted. But while granting adjournment it is appropriate to impose costs on complainant. Hence, I pass following order. This is last adjournment is subject to cost of Rs.500/-. Further, complainant is directed to present before court and secure presence of witness on next date without fail.
