2. Heard learned Advocate A. S. Kapare for the complainant.
3. The offences alleged against accused are punishable under sections 384, 506 read with 34 of The Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under section 200 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. As per averments in complaint, affidavit and verification, I am of the opinion that other sufficient evidence is required for further proceedings. It is also alleged that, accused no.1 and 2 dishonestly induces in the complainant to deliver property or money of Rs.20 Lakh. Considering the submissions, documents on record, a prima facie case under section 384, 506 r.w. 34 of the Indian Penal Code 1860 is made out against the accused. There is a dispute between complainant and accused under regarding property. There are sufficient grounds to proceed against the accused for an offence punishable under sections 384, 506 r.w. 34 of the Indian Penal Code 1860. In view of above discussion, I pass following order.

ORDER

Issue process against accused no. 1 and 2 under sections 384, 506 read with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code 1860, vide Section 204 of Code of Criminal Procedure returnable on 06.10.2025.
