



ORDER BELOW EXH.-86

01. This is an application filed by the innocent accused person in view of Section 239 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short Cr.PC) for discharged.

02. It is the contention of accused that he is facing trial for offence punishable under Section 420, 409, 465, 468, 166, 167, R/w. Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short IPC).

03. He has further contended that, on the basis of inquiry report stamp order was passed by this Court and thereby process was issued on 20.01.2018 against the accused persons for the above sections. The accused had approached in the revision to the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, which was dismissed. Police has submitted B summary. The said report and all documents annexed with the said report does not show involvement of the accused and charge of offence is groundless against the all accused persons. Hence, prayed to discharge them from the matter.

04. The advocate for complainant has filed his say backside of the application and opposed the application of accused. He has contended that, on 20.11.2018 the Ld. trial Court has issued process. The accused preferred Criminal Revision Application no.66/2018 before the Ld. Sessions Court, which was dismissed and confirmed the order of issuing process. Hence, he prayed to reject the application.

05. Heard Ld. advocate for accused and complainant. I have gone

through the record. It appears that, police has filed B summary report. Thereafter, Court passed an order and directed complainant to lead evidence. After leading evidence process was issued against the accused. Though, the police report does not show allegation against the accused but the complainant has lead an evidence. The evidence led by complainant prima-facie shows the case against the accused has been made out. Therefore, in my opinion, accused are not entitled for discharged. Hence, I pass the following order:-

ORDER

Application is rejected.
