



**Vikram Prakash Kedari and
Prakash Sakharam Kedari.**

Vs.

State of Maharashtra and Anr.

ORDER BELOW EXH-1

1. Apprehending arrest in Crime No.I- 567/2026 registered by M.I.D.C. Police Station, Ahmednagar for the offences punishable under Sections 118(1), 118(2), 115(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, applicants/accused preferred the present application under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (herein after referred as 'BNSS') seeking anticipatory bail.
2. The applicants/accused contended that, they are falsely implicated in this case. There is delay of three days in lodging the FIR. No allegations made against present applicant in the FIR. The applicant No.1 is student and applicant No.2 is old person. Nothing is to be recovered from them. They are ready to abide any terms and conditions. Lastly, they prayed for allowing their application.
3. The prosecution even after availing much time did not file its say.
4. Heard learned advocate Smt. M.G. Nanekar for the applicants/accused and learned APP Shri. A.D. Dhage for the State.
5. It is pertinent to note that after perusing the FIR which is lodged by Milind Kedare, the main role of assaulting him by knife is against Vinayak Prakash Kedare who is not in the array of present applicant. Only allegation against present applicants is that they

were hurling abuses when Vinayak Kedare was assaulting the informant by knife. The applicants were not with any armed weapon at the time incident. Nothing is to be recovered from them. Their custodial interrogation is not necessary. They are entitled to pre-arrest bail. Accordingly, I pass following order.

ORDER

- 1] Criminal Bail Application No.1354/2026 is allowed.
- 2] In the event of arrest of the applicants/accused **Vikram Prakash Kedari and Prakash Sakharam Kedari** in connection with Crime No. I- 567/2026 registered with M.I.D.C. Police Station, Ahmednagar, they be released on bail on their furnishing PR and SB of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) **each** with one surety of like amount, on the following conditions :-
 - i) The applicants/accused shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer or tamper with the evidence.
 - ii) The applicants/accused shall not commit similar offence.
 - iii) The applicants/accused shall attend the concerned police station as and when asked by the Investigating Officer and co-operate in the investigation.
- 3] Inform the concerned police station.
