ORDER BELOW EXH.1

Applicant Nos.[1] Pravin Anil Jadhav, [2] Sonu Anil Jadhav, [3] Anil Petras Jadhav, [4] Sachin Anil Jadhav, [5] Pooja Sachin Jadhav, [6] Shubhangi Sachin Kolge and [7] Seema Ravi Salve have filed this application under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with the C.R.No.119/2026 under Sections 85, 115(2), 351(2) and 352 read with Sec.3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at MIDC Waluj Police Station, Tal. Gangapur, Dist. Chhatrapati- Sambhajanagar.

[2] Brief facts of the prosecution case are as under :-

The informant is the wife of applicant No.1, whereas other applicants are her in-laws. On 16.12.2026 she lodged FIR alleging that when she was cohabiting with the applicants, they used to ill-treat her to meet their unlawful demand of Rs.50,000/- for opening new medical store. As she failed to fulfill their demands, they caused her physical and mental harassment. Such last incident of harassment was happened on 08.12.2020 and since then she is residing at her maternal house. On the basis of the FIR, crime vide C.R. No.119/2026 came to be registered. The applicants have apprehension of their arrest. Hence, they have filed application for grant of anticipatory bail.

[3] I have heard both the sides and perused the material placed on the record.

[4] It appears that last incident of alleged harassment happened on 08.12.2020 and the present FIR came to be filed on 16.02.2026. Thus, there is more than five years delay in lodging FIR. The delay is inordinate and unexplained, which creates reasonable doubt about the genuineness of the allegations made in the FIR.

[5] From the allegations made against the applicants it appears that it is matrimonial dispute between the parties. Even if, the allegations made by the informant are taken to be

true and correct, at this juncture nothing is to be discovered or recovered from the applicants. Therefore, their custodial interrogation appears not to be necessary. However, since the crime is registered for non-bailable offences against the applicants, possibility of their arrest cannot be ruled out. Therefore, considering the nature of the dispute between parties, I am of the opinion that, it would be just and proper to grant anticipatory bail to the applicants. I, therefore, pass the following order:-

ORDER

(1) In the event of arrest of applicant Nos. [1] **Pravin Anil Jadhav**, [2] **Sonu Anil Jadhav**, [3] **Anil Petras Jadhav**, [4] **Sachin Anil Jadhav**, [5] **Pooja Sachin Jadhav**, [6] **Shubhangi Sachin Kolge** and [7] **Seema Ravi Salve**, in the matter of C.R.No.119/2026 under Sections 85, 115(2), 351(2) and 352 read with Sec.3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 registered at **MIDC Waluj** Police Station, Tal. Gangapur, Dist. Chhatrapati- Sambhajinagar, they be released on their executing P.R. bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand only) **each** with surety of like amount on the following conditions that :-

(a) applicant Nos. [1] **Pravin Anil Jadhav** and [3] **Anil Petras Jadhav** shall remain present at **MIDC Waluj** Police Station, Tal. Gangapur, Dist. Chhatrapati- Sambhajinagar, on every **Sunday from 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. till next 60 days** or filing of charge-sheet whichever is earlier.

(b) that the applicants shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner.

(c) at the time of furnishing bail the applicants shall produce on record their residential proof.
