State of Maharashtra Vs. Rajan TAWARE & Ors

ORDER BELOW EXH.5

(Passed on 29.04.2025)

1. This is an application under section 483 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of bail to applicants-accused Nos. 1 to 3.
2. The respondent-state has filed its say and resisted the application.
3. Heard learned Advocate Shri.A. C. Khavle Patil on behalf of the applicants-accused and learned APP Shri. K.S. Gande on behalf of respondent-state.
4. Previously accused Nos. 1 to 3 were released on bail by the concern police. However, now the concern police have completed the investigation and filed charge-sheet. The alleged offences are not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. The accused Nos. 1 to 3 are permanent resident of village Shivrai, Tq. Gangapur and they are having roots in the society. Hence, the order.

ORDER

1. The application (Exh.5) is allowed.
2. The applicants-accused Ranjan Namdev Taware, Lahu Raibhan Navpute and Anand Rajan Taware, be released on bail in Crime No.370/2024, registered at Waluj Police Station under section 118(10, 125, 115(2), 352 of the Bhartiya Nayaya Sanhita, 2023, u/s 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act on their executing personal bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rs.

Twenty five Thousand only) each with one surety of like amount.

3. The applicants-accused shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.
