**ORDER BELOW EXH.-14**

1. This is an application under section 478 and 480 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of bail to applicant-accused No.4 to 6 and 8.
2. The respondent-state has filed its say overleaf the application and resisted the application.
3. Heard learned Advocate Shri. P. R. Barde on behalf of the applicant-accused and learned APP Shri.K.S. Gande on behalf of respondent-state.
4. Previously accused Nos. 4 to 6 and 8 were given notice by the police and released as they were charged for the offence punishable under section 9, 10 and 11 of the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act. Now, the concern police have completed the investigation and filed chargesheet. The alleged offences are not serious and investigation is completed. So the accused are entitle for bail. Hence, the order.

- 1) The application (Exh.-14) is allowed.
- 2) The applicant-accused No. 4 to 6 and 8 be released on bail on executing of their personal bond of Rs.15,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand Only) each with one surety bond of like amount in.
- 3) They shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
- 4) They shall not repeat similar kind of offences.
