Fresh complaint case under Electricity Act, 2003 filed. It be checked and registered.

Present - Sh. Pankaj Bhatti, AR of the complainant with counsel
Sh. Deepak Pathak.

Heard. Record perused. On the basis of complaint and supporting documents, cognizance of offence punishable under Section 135 of Electricity Act, 2003 is taken.

In pre-summoning evidence, Sh. Pankaj Bhatti, AR/Sr.Manager (Legal) examined as CW1. Further affidavit of Sh. Chander Kant (DE) filed. He is examined as CW-2. On separate statement of the AR of the complainant, pre-summoning evidence is closed.

Arguments heard on the point of summoning. In the complaint Ex.CW1/A and documentary evidence on record i.e. Ex.CW2/A colly to Ex.CW2/F, it is mentioned that the accused were found committing theft of electricity in the premises in question as described in the inspection report. Hence, I am of the considered opinion that there are sufficient grounds to proceed against the accused for the offence punishable u/s. 1350 of Electricity Act, 2003.

Let summons be issued to the accused through SHO of PS concerned. One of the Raiding Team Members namely, Sh. Chander Kant (DET) Mobile No. 9911638877 shall accompany police official for assistance needed to identify the accused and premises. PF and copy of complaint be filed within two weeks.

Matter be listed for report on summons for **26.07.2025**.
