Non-bailable warrants issued against accused received back unexecuted. Hence, from the report it appears that accused is absconding from the execution of warrants and hence, he cannot be served through ordinary process. From these facts and circumstances, let, the presence of the accused is to be secured through proclamation U/s 82 Cr.P.C. the proclamation against accused be issued for **6.6.2024** in following terms:-

The proclamation shall be published as follows:

- (a) It shall be publicly read in some conspicuous place of the town or village in which such person ordinarily resides;
- (b) It shall be affixed to some conspicuous part of the house or homestead in which such person ordinarily resides or to some conspicuous place of such town or village.
- (c) A copy thereof shall be affixed to some conspicuous part of the court house.

The proclamation be issued accordingly. The report of the proclamation be awaited on **6.5.2024**. Tamil is directed to appear in the Court for making his statement for due publication for the date fixed.
