**SESSIONS COURT AT BEED.****Criminal M.A. No. 29/2026****Anurath S/o. Malhari Darade & another****Vs.****State of Maharashtra & others****ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

The applicants have filed this application under Section 448 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, for transfer of Regular Criminal case No. 462/2024, Regular Criminal Case No.467/2024, Summary Criminal Case No. 809/2024 and Summary Criminal Case No. 810/2024 pending at different Court s at Beed to one Court at Beed for disposal.

1. Heard Ld. Counsel for Applicant and Ld. APP B S Rakh for State. Respondents No.2 to 7 proceeded ex-parte.

2. Upon hearing it is evident that, incident in RCC No.462/2024 and 467/2024 happened on same date, time and place i.e. on 06/05/2024 at about 10.30 to 11.00 a.m. near Mukta Lawns Beed. Both cases are counter and the parties involved are one and same and for convenience of parties to lead evidence and

to avoid conflicting decisions, both matters requires to be tried by one and same Court. Out of above RCC No.467/2024 is pending in the Court of 8th Jt. Civil Judge, S.D. & Addl. CJM Beed and RCC No.462/2024 pending before the Court of Jt. Civil Judge, J.D. & JMFC Beed. They both needs to be tried by one court.

3. In respect of SCC No. 809/2024 and 810/2024 are concerned, it is evident that, non-applicant No.2 filed both the cases against applicants for offence u/sec. 138 of N. I. Act. Out of above SCC No. 809/2024 are pending in the Court of 8th Jt. Civil Judge, S.D. & Addl. CJM Beed and SCC No. 810/2024 is pending before Ld. 7th Jt. Civil Judge, S.D. & Addl. CJM Beed. They also both needs to be tried by one court.

4. Since cases filed under IPC and cases filed under Negotiable Instruments Act are arising out of different cause of action and as both Acts are operating under different fields, all these cases cannot be tried together. Considering this, I accordingly pass the following order;

ORDER

- 1] Application is partly allowed.
- 2] Regular Criminal Case No. 467/2024 pending before Ld. 8th Joint Civil Judge, (Senior Division) & Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Beed is hereby withdrawn and made over to the Court of Ld. Joint Civil Judge, (J.D.) & Judicial Magistrate, Beed for disposal according to law alongwith Regular Criminal Case No. 462/2024 for disposal according to law.
