A W A R D

This proceeding is kept in today's '**National Lok-Adalat**' held on 09th May 2026. Claimants No. 1 and 2 are present before the National Lok-Adalat. Respondent No. 2 Insurance Company filed authority letter Exh.20 authorizing Advocate Shri. S.M.Salve to compromise the matter. The claimants and respondent No. 2 have filed compromise memo (Exh.25). The claimants and respondent No.2 are identified by the learned Counsel Shri. N.N.Sable and Shri. S.M.Salve. The contents of compromise memo (Exh.25) are read over and explained to the claimants and Advocate of Respondent No.2. They admit to be true and correct. Hence read and recorded. Claimants have filed compensation amount apportionment pursis at Exh.26. Claimant No.2 Babasaheb Bhavar filed his affidavit that, the deceased Mahesh s/o. Babasaheb Bhavar was their son and he was unmarried at the time of his death, therefore, claimants are only the legal heirs of deceased. Accordingly, following order is passed.

:: O R D E R ::

- 1) The proceeding stands withdrawn against respondent No.1 in view of pursis Exh.21.
- 2) The claim petition is disposed of as compromise as per terms and conditions of compromise memo (Exh.25).
- 3) Respondent No.2 Insurance company shall pay the amount of **Rs.14,40,000/- (In words Rs. Forteen Lakh Forty Thousand only)** by way of RTGS / NEFT in Bank Account No.40780491353, State Bank of India, Branch Rajuri-ves IFSC Code No.SBIN0020028 Beed Tq. & Dist. Beed in the name of Ex-officio member, MACT, Beed. If respondent No.2 insurance company fails to pay the

amount within 8 weeks, the compensation amount would carry simple interest @ 5% per annum, from the date of order till its realization thereof.

- 4) Respondent No.2 shall pay the said amount only by way of RTGS / NEFT in the bank account of this Court as per above details, on due verification.
- 5) Upon receipt of the said payment, it shall be apportioned as follows:
 - i) Asstt. Superintendent (Cash and Finance) shall pay **Rs.7,20,000/- (In words Rs. Seven Lakh Twenty Thousand only)** each to claimant No.1) Shantabai w/o. Babasaheb Bhavar and claimant No.2) Babasaheb s/o. Raghunath Bhavar being parents of the deceased by way of R.T.G.S./NEFT only in the bank account of claimants on due verification.
- 6) Court fees be refunded to the claimant as per the Rules.
- 7) No order as to costs.
