ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 4.

Read the application, say of prosecution and adjoining documents on record.

2) Ld. Advocate for the applicants/accused submitted that Investigating Officer gave notices under Section 35(3) of the BNS to the applicants. Thereafter after completion of investigation charge-sheet is filed. The applicants has no antecedents. Ad-interim protection is granted to the applicants. The applicants has firm roots in the society. They are ready to obey any conditions and prayed to confirm ad-interim protection granted to the applicants.

3) Ld. APP for the State submitted that the offence is serious in nature. Police papers show involvement of the applicants. If bail is granted, the applicants will tamper with the prosecution evidence and prayed to reject the application.

4) It emerges from the documents on record that C.R. No.244/2025 registered with Police Station, Shivajinagar, Beed Tq. & Dist. Beed for the offences punishable under Sections 74, 79, 115(2), 352, 351(3) read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and

under Sections 3(1)(r)(s), 3(1)(w)(i)(ii), 3(2)(va) of the SC & ST Act is registered against the applicants/accused. Thereafter on 24/12/2025 the applicants surrendered before this Court and on same day interim bail was granted. There is nothing on record to show that the applicants committed breach of any of the conditions of the interim bail granted on 24/12/2025. No antecedents of the applicants are brought on record. Investigation is completed and charge-sheet is filed. The applicants has firm roots in the society. So presence of the applicants can be secured at the time of the trial. In the circumstances, it would be appropriate to confirm interim bail granted to the applicants on same conditions. In the result following order is passed :-

:: ORDER ::

- 1] The application (Exh.04) is allowed by confirming interim protection dated 24/12/2025 granted to the applicants.
- 2] The applicants/accused Nos. 1) Vasant Kerba Khedkar and 2) Pushpa w/o Vasant Khedkar be released on regular bail in C.R. No.244/2025 registered with Police Station, Shivajinagar, Beed Tq. & Dist. Beed for the offences punishable under Sections 74, 79, 115(2), 352, 351(3) read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and under Sections 3(1)(r)(s), 3(1)(w)(i)(ii), 3(2)(va) of the SC & ST Act on their executing PB and SB of Rs.15,000/- each, on same conditions as mentioned in interim order dated 24/12/2025.
- 3) Inform concerned police station accordingly.

- 2) Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicants/accused.
- 3) It emerges from the documents on record that C.R. No.244/2025 registered with Police Station, Shivajinagar, Beed Tq. & Dist. Beed for the offences punishable under Sections 74, 79, 115(2), 352, 351(3) read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and under Sections 3(1)(r)(s), 3(1)(w)(i)(ii), 3(2)(va) of the SC & ST Act is registered against the applicants/accused. Today applicants/accused appeared/surrendered before the Court. It is noticed that the IO gave notice under Section 35(3) of BNSS to the applicant. Charge-sheet is filed. Therefore prima facie custodial interrogation of the applicants does not appear warranted. The applicants have firm root in the society. Hence it would appropriate to grant interim bail to the applicants/accused. Hence following order is passed :-

ORDER

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) The applicants/accused Nos. 1) Vasant Kerba Khedkar and 2) Pushpa w/o Vasant Khedkar be released on interim bail in C.R. No.244/2025 registered with Police Station, Shivajinagar, Beed Tq. & Dist. Beed for the offences punishable under Sections 74, 79, 115(2), 352, 351(3) read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and under Sections 3(1)(r)(s), 3(1)(w)(i)(ii), 3(2)(va) of the SC & ST Act on their executing PB and SB of Rs.15,000/- each.
- 3) The applicants/accused persons shall attend the Court on fixed dates, unless their attendance is specifically exempted.
- 4) Inform concerned Police Station accordingly.
