ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

Being aggrieved by the Judgment and order passed in Regular Civil Suit No. 322/2023 by Ld. Joint Civil Judge Junior Division, Ashti, Dist. Beed on 09/05/2025, the applicant/ original plaintiff had filed an appeal under Section 96 of the Code of Civil Procedure before this Court, but since there is delay of 2 months and 16 days, hence he has filed this application for condonation of delay.
