ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 14.

This is a second regular bail application filed by applicant/accused namely **Juned s/o Anwar Sayyed** under Section 483 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, in connection with CR No.96/2025 registered with Police Station, Peth Beed Tq. & Dist. Beed for the offences punishable under Sections 4, 25 of Arms Act and under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 189(2), 189(4), 190, 191(2), 351(2), 352 of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita (for short BNS).

2) According to the prosecution on 26/03/2025 quarrel took place between informant and co-accused Aftab Sayyad. On 27/03/2025 one of the accused made phone call to informant and called him at his house to settle the quarrel. Accordingly informant, his brother and nephew went in front of house of informant. At that time present applicant and co-accused persons abused, threatened and assaulted informant, his brother and nephew by means of sword, kukari, stone as well as by fist and leg blows with intent to kill them. Accordingly report came to be lodged.

3) The applicant inter-alia contended that the applicant is innocent and has been falsely roped in this crime. There are vague allegations against the applicant in the FIR. Police have seized

weapons and DVR. Previous bail application of the applicant is rejected as investigation was in progress. Now charge-sheet is filed. Further detention of the applicant in Jail is not required. Co-accused are enlarged on bail. Applicant is ready to obey any conditions and prayed to allow the application.

4) The application is further resisted by Ld. APP for the State by filing say. It is contended therein that the police papers show active involvement of the applicant. Offence is serious in nature. The applicant has antecedents. Filing of charge-sheet is not change in circumstance. If bail is granted, the applicant will tamper with the prosecution evidence and prayed to reject the application.

5) Heard learned Advocate for applicant/accused and Ld. APP for the State. Ld. Advocate for the applicant, Ld. APP for State argued on the line of their respective say.

6) It emerges from the police papers that at the relevant time of alleged incident present applicant allegedly gave a blow of sword on left hand of informant's nephew. The police have seized weapons of offence. It appears that the applicant has also lodged report against the informant with respect to alleged incident. Be that as it may, the applicant is arrested on 15/05/2025. Till 19/05/2025 the applicant was in police custody and thereafter as per request of the Investigating Officer the applicant was sent to Magisterial custody. No previous conviction to the credit of the applicant is brought on record. Previous bail application of the applicant No.508/2025 came to be rejected as the investigation was in progress. Now investigation is completed and charge-sheet is filed. Co-accused are enlarged on bail. Informant and

injured are also discharged. Further detention of the applicant in Jail does not appear warranted. The applicant has firm roots in the society. So presence of the applicant can be secured at the time of trial. Hence it would be appropriate to enlarge the applicant on bail. Apprehension of the prosecution can be taken care of by imposing certain conditions on the applicant. In the result following order is passed :-

ORDER

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) The applicant/accused namely **Juned s/o Anwar Sayyed** be released on bail in CR No.96/2025 registered with Police Station, Peth Beed Tq. & Dist. Beed for the offences punishable under Sections 4, 25 of Arms Act and under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 189(2), 189(4), 190, 191(2), 351(2), 352 of BNS on his executing PB and SB of Rs.30,000/-.
- 3) The applicant/accused shall not directly or indirectly tamper with the prosecution evidence.
- 4) The applicant/accused shall produce his residential proofs such as Ration card or Adhar card or electricity bill etc. to show his permanent place of residence, at the time of furnishing surety in the Court.
- 5) The applicant/accused shall attend the Court on fixed dates, unless his attendance is specifically exempted.
- 6) The applicant/accused shall not commit similar or any other offence.
- 7) Copy of this order be sent to Jail authority, Beed through E-mail.
