ORDER BELOW EXH.3

01] This is an application filed for bail by the accused No.1 and 2 for the offences punishable under sections 352, 351(2), 351(3) read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

02] At the outset, it is pertinent to note that during investigation, the investigating officer had issued notice under section 35(3) of the B.N.S.S. to the accused and thereby the accused were not arrested. Now the charge-sheet has been filed.

03] Heard learned advocate for the accused No.1 and 2.

04] Considering that the offence alleged under the provisions of SC and ST Act, I find it necessary to issue notice to the informant and hear the informant also. In the meantime, considering that the charge-sheet is already filed, I find it would be just and proper to grant interim bail to the accused and pass following order.

ORDER

- 1] Applicants/Accused No.1 and 2 be released on interim bail and directed to furnish PB and SB of Rs.25,000/- each on the following conditions:-

- i] Applicants shall not tamper with the evidence of prosecution and witnesses in any manner.
- ii] Applicants shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to deceive them from disclosing such facts to the Court or any Police Officer.
- iii] Accused /applicants shall attend each and every fixed dates in the Court at 11.00 a.m. sharp without giving any excuses.
