01. Through the judgment dated 15.09.2023 delivered by Ld. JMFC Court, Georai in RCC No. 156/2020 (State Vs. Shyam and ors.), accused have been convicted as under.

02. A1 Shyam, A2 Balu, A3 Dnyandeo, A4 Sunita and A5 Sangita have been convicted for few offences as under.
 - a. Each accused is convicted for offence PUS 147 r.w. 149 and sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment for three months.
 - b. Each accused is convicted for offence PUS 148 r.w. 149 and sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment for six months.
 - c. Each accused is convicted for offence PUS 323 r.w. 149 and sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment for three months.
 - d. Each accused is convicted for offence PUS 326 r.w. 149 and sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment for six months and fine of Rs. 1,000/- each. Default sentence is simple imprisonment of one month.

03. All the sentences are directed to run concurrently.

04. Appeal against conviction is a valuable right. Present is criminal appeal against impugned judgment of conviction. Shri. V. D. Nagargoje, Ld. Advocate for accused / appellants urged for suspension of substantive sentences.

05. From today, till decision of appeal, I suspend substantive sentences. Likewise, I order release of appellants on personal bonds of Rs. 15,000/- each with one surety in the like amount. Appellants are prepared to deposit the fine amount here. They shall deposit the fine amount here on or before 17.10.2023. Inform the LTC. Hence, this order.
