ORDER BELOW EXH.01.

1. The applicant Bibhishan s/o. Jagannath Landge, prays for regular bail under section 483 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in crime No.53/2026 registered at Parli city police station for the offence punishable under sections 303(2) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and section 4,21 of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957.
2. One Subham Ramhari Ghule, PSO, police station Parli City, lodged a report that on 08.03.2026 at 10.00 p.m. in front of Kalratri temple on Dharmapuri to Parli road at Dharmapuri the accused No.1 Bibhishan was carrying illegally without paying royalty and permit 5 brass sand of worth Rs.75,000/- by loading in Tata highway tipper bearing No.MH-26-BE-1933. He seized said sand and hywa truck. On asking, the accused No.1 Bibhishan Landge told that the accused No.1 Harischandra Rupnar R/o. Gadepimpalgaon, Tq. Parli Vaijnath is owner of said tipper and he brought said sand from village Dharked, Tq. Gangakhed at the instance of accused No.2. Accordingly, he lodged report.

3. As per applicant, he has not committed any offence. He has been falsely implicated in the above crime. The learned A.P.P. and IO contested the application by filing say at Exh.6 and 7. Both submitted that the applicant committed a serious offence. There is a possibility of putting pressure on prosecution witnesses. The learned A.P.P. submitted that the custodial interrogation of applicant is necessary for recovery of muddemal.

4. Heard learned advocate for the applicant and learned A.P.P. Perused the police papers. It shows that the applicant is arrested on the day of raid i.e. on 09.03.2026 and on the same day he is remanded to judicial custody. The stolen property i.e. sand and truck is already seized. Nothing is remained to be recovered. The investigation is almost completed. Therefore, further custodial interrogation of the applicant is not required. Therefore, it is necessary to release the applicant on bail. Hence order.

ORDER

- A. Cri. Bail Application No.105/2026 is allowed with conditions.
- B. The applicant be released on bail on furnishing his PB of Rs.50,000/- with surety in like amount subject to condition that he shall attend the court date regularly.
- C. He shall assist in the investigation.
- D. In view of judgment passed in SMW (Cr) No.04 of
