ORDER BELOW EXH.4

The main application is moved by the applicant-accused under Section 482 of BNSS in connection with C.R.No. 263/2026 registered with City Police Station, Majalgaon for the offence under Section 105 read with Section 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. The present ad-interim anticipatory bail application is moved for ad-interim anticipatory bail protection.

2. Heard Ld. Adv. V. B. Kadam for the applicant/accused vehemently submitted that there is no role played by this applicant in commission of crime as this offence being punishable under Section 305 read with Section 3(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. The applicant was the contractor. He has given the work to the sub-contractor. He was not present on the plot. The FIR does not disclose any specific overt-act committed personally by this applicant, which resulted in the deceased coming into contact with electric line. He has merely place role as a contractor. I have gone through the allegations alongwith the FIR, which results that there is involvement of electric personnel, electric lineman, contractor, sub-contractor and MSEB, Junior Engineer. It is necessary to do investigation pertaining to the cause of incident, which resulted death of this

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person by electrocution, as suddenly the electric supply was started. Therefore, unless, the prosecution is heard, I am of the opinion that, this is not the fit case for the ad-interim relief and protection in terms of anticipatory bail. Hence, following order : -

ORDER

1. Application below Exh.4 is hereby rejected.
2. Issue Notice learned APP for State/ Investigation Officer for calling say.
3. Returnable On 14/08/2026.
