ORDER BELOW EXH 1

The claimant along-with his learned advocate Shri. M.R.Sugare are present. Respondent No.2 Insurance company through its learned advocate Shri.S.N.Gurav is present.

Parties arrived at compromise and filed compromise pursis at Exh.10. The matter is settled between the parties for compensation of Rs.4,12,000/- (Rs. Four Lakhs Twelve thousand only). Parties admitted the contents of compromise. Since the matter is settled between the claimants and respondent insurance company, it is not necessary to keep it pending. Hence, following order.

ORDER

- (i) In view of compromise Exh.10 and Award Exh.12, the claim petition is disposed of for the compensation amount of Rs.04,12,000/- (Rs. Four lakhs twelve thousand only).
- (ii) After depositing the settlement amount, it be paid to the claimant by issuing an account payee cheque/ NEFT/ RTGS or electronic transfer in any nationalized bank after due verification.
- (iii) Court fee be refunded to the claimants as per rule.
