ORDER BELOW EXH.1.

The Hon'ble High Court of Bombay and District Legal Services Authority, Beed as per letter outward no. 680/2026, dated 22/04/2026 directed to dispose of cases u/s 256 and Section 258 of Code of Criminal Procedure (Section 279 and Section 281 of B.N.S.S.) on the working day prior to five days i.e. during 04.05.2026 to 08.05.2026 of National Lok Adalat to be held on 9th May, 2026. Hence, the instant case has been taken in special drive for appropriate order.

2. The instant matter is of the year **2024**. Charge-sheet is filed on **30/04/2024**. Since then accused is absent in this proceedings. Several times summons issued even though prosecution could not secured the presence of accused. In such circumstances there is no point in keeping the matter pending.

3. In this backdrop, this is the fit case for invoking the powers under section 258 of Criminal Procedure Code. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The proceeding of present case is stopped under Section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and thereby the case is disposed off.
2. Accused namely **Chandu Hasan Parasuwale** is discharged for the offence punishable under section 65(e) of Maharashtra Prohibition Act, 1949.

3. Seized muddemal amount of Rs. 700/- vide MR No. 24/2024 be disposed off according to law after appeal period is over.
