Heard Ld. Advocate for plaintiff. Perused the plaint and documents. The plaintiff has filed the present suit for recovery of Rs. 7,70,747/- with interest against the defendants. The suit is valued at Rs. 7,70,747/- for the purpose of the Court fees and pecuniary jurisdiction. The pecuniary jurisdiction of this Court extends only up to Rs. 5,00,000/-. Therefore, this Court has no pecuniary jurisdiction to entertain and try present suit.

The plaintiff has filed an application requesting that the suit be placed before the Court of Civil Judge Senior Division. However, when a Court finds that it has no jurisdiction to try the suit, the proper course is to return the plaint under Order VII Rule 10 of Code of Civil Procedure for presentation before the competent Court. Hence, the plaint is liable to be returned to the plaintiff for its presentation to proper Court. Hence, I pass following order;
