**ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

As per the directions of Hon'ble High Court and Hon'ble District Court vide letter No.B(Gen)-1001/2026/615 dated 20/04/2026, the unattended, old, stale and ineffective cases needs to be disposed of on priority basis in order to reduce the pendency of such old cases. Therefore, special drive has been organized as per the directions of Hon'ble High Court, regarding disposal of petty cases.

2. This is a summary proceeding filed on 04/03/2023 for offence punishable under D.V Act, 2005. This is about 3 years old case and still pending for dismissal order. The complainant has neither remain present nor taken steps for appearance of non-applicant, though more than sufficient opportunity has been given.

3. In such circumstances, considering the age of matter and taking in view the nature of alleged offence, I am of candid opinion that, no fruitful purpose will be served in keeping this matter pending for years together at the stage of appearance of non applicant without any effective proceeding. This is a fit case to invoke the powers under section 256 of Cr.P.C. for stopping the proceeding. In the result, I pass following order:

**ORDER**

Case is disposed of under Section 256 of Cr.P.C. Proceeding is closed.
