## JUDGMENT

Particulars of offence read over and explained to accused in vernacular. They pleads guilty. Consequence of their plea and punishment that may be imposed on them again explained to them. Still, they pleads guilty. I found their plead to be voluntary one. Hence, I held them guilty for offence under Section 12A of Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act. I stop to hear the accused on the point of sentence. They submits that, they are poor so leniency may be shown to them and kindly requested to award minimum & lessor punishment. Considering the nature of offence and submissions made by accused, I think following sentence will meet the ends of justice. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order;

### O R D E R

- 1] Accused are convicted for the offence punishable under Section 12(a) of Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act and sentenced to suffer imprisonment till rising of Court and to pay fine of Rs.300/- (In words Rs. Three hundred only) each in default, to suffer simple imprisonment for the period three days vide section 252 of Code of Criminal Procedure
  
- 2] Seized Muddemal amount of Rs.1,770/-be credited to Government and remaining muddemal being worthless, be destroyed after appeal period is over. Seized mobile phones of Samsung company and Kechaoda company be returned to its original owner after due verification of documents if not already returned after appeal period is over.
  
- 3] Copy of judgement be given to accused immediately, free of costs.
