ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT-1

This is the proceeding filed for the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. In this case, today complainant bank appeared before the Lok Adalat along with his counsel and filed pursis at **Exh. 7** that, matter was compromised with the accused before Lok Adalat. According to complainant, accused has deposited entire cheque amount with the complainant bank. Therefore, complainant do not want to proceed in the matter and wants to withdraw it. 4. Court fees be refunded to the complainant as per rules.
