

**ORDER BELOW EXH. 1**

- 1.** This is the proceeding filed against the accused for the offence punishable u/s. **12 (a) of the Bombay Prevention of Gambling Act and Section 188, 269, 270 of IPC and section 51 B of National Disaster Management Act** . In this case, accused is/are not appearing for the trial and prosecution has failed to produce the accused before the Court for trial.
- 2.** As per office order of Hon'ble District Legal Service Authority, Beed bearing outward No. 322/2026 dated 16.02.2026 it was directed to undertake special drive during 09.03.2026 to 13.03.2026 to dispose off cases under section 256 and 258 of Cr.P.C. Therefore, this case was kept for disposal in special drive.
- 3.** As per section 258 of Cr.P.C. in any summons case instituted otherwise than upon complaint, a Magistrate of the First Class or with the previous sanction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate any other Judicial Magistrate may for reasons to be recorded by him, stop the proceeding at any stage without pronouncing any judgment and where such stoppage of proceeding is made after the evidence of the principal witnesses has been recorded, pronounce judgment of acquittal, and in any other case release the accused and such release shall have the effect of discharge.
- 4.** In the present case though the opportunity was given to the prosecution to secure the attendance of the accused, since long prosecution / police have not secured attendance of the accused. This is the sufficient ground to stop this proceeding as for about **Six years** prosecution have failed to secure attendance of the accused.

ii) Other Seized mudemmal being worthless be destroyed after the appeal is over, if any.  
  
iii) Seized mobiles be given to the original owner after due verification, if any.
