3. It appears from perusal of the record that, the accused was absence for while and trial could not commence due to absence of the accused. In this case accused is alleged to have been committed offences punishable under section 498-A of I.P.C. While granting the bail court has to consider presence of accused. Their presence can be secured by putting appropriate condition. Accused are ready to obey any condition imposed by the court. They are ready to furnish bail bond as per order. Herein this case charge-sheet has been filed. In the circumstances no purpose would be serve to keep the accused behind bar. It is true alleged offence is serious in nature but not punishable with death punishment or life imprisonment hence considering the stage of matter and nature of offence I pass following order.

**ORDER**

- 1] Accused be released on bail on executing P.R. for Rs.15,000/- and on furnishing S.B. of like amount for accused No.1 and 3 to 6.
- 2] It is directed to accused he shall attend court regularly.
- 3] They shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
