

**ORDER BELOW EXH. 1**

In the present matter, accused are prosecuted for the commission of offence punishable U/sec. 323 and 504 r/w. 34 of Indian Penal Code.

2. Perused record and proceeding. On perusal of record it appears that, on appearance of accused persons plea was recorded on 29/11/2022. Since then matter is adjourned for hearing. But record shows that, complainant remain absent since long. She failed to lead evidence inspite of sufficient opportunity till date. Today also complainant remain absent. Adjournment application filed by complainant's advocate is rejected. There is no progress in matter. Already, matter is kept for dismissal order since 21/01/2026. Considering all those aspects it appears that complainant is not interested to proceed with the matter. For that reason it needs to dispose of the proceeding U/sec. 256 of Cr.P.C. for want of complainant and her evidence. Hence, the following order.

**ORDER**

- 1) The complaint is disposed U/sec. 256 of Code of Criminal Procedure for want of complainant and her evidence.
- 2) Accused are acquitted.
- 3) Their bail bonds stands cancelled.
