COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH.1 & 9 IN S.C.C.NO. 94/2025

Present application is filed by the complainant with a prayer to transfer the present complaint to the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Beed on jurisdictional ground.

2. The complainant contended that, he has deposited the disputed cheque in the Bank of Maharashtra, Branch Nagar Road, Beed. Therefore the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Beed has a jurisdiction to try and decide this case. Hence he prayed to transfer the present case to the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Beed vide section 201 of Cr. P.C. (Section 224 of B.N.S.S.).

3. Considering the prayer of the complainant section 142 sub section (2) of N.I. Act shows that all other Courts are barred to inquire in to and to try the offence punishable under section 138, except within whose local jurisdiction- (a) if the cheque is delivered for collection through an account, the branch of the bank where the payee or holder in due course, as the case may be, maintain the account, is situated; or (b) if the cheque is presented for payment by the payee or holder in due course otherwise through an account, the branch of the drawee bank where the drawer maintains the account, is situated.

4. After perusing the complaint and other documents along with it, it appears that the cheque in this case is deposited at Bank of Maharashtra, Branch Nagar Road, Beed. Therefore, the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Beed has the jurisdiction to try this complainant.

Hence, as per specific content of 142 sub section (2) of N.I.Act, this court has no jurisdiction to try the present complaint. Accordingly, the present complaint is required to be returned in original to the complainant to file the same before appropriate jurisdiction of the Court under section 224 of B.N.S.S. (section 201(a) of Cr.P.C.) within one month of this order. Documents be returned in original after taking Photostat copies of the same and thereafter file be consigned to record room after due compliance.
