**ORDER BELOW EXH. NO. 1**

Perused the record. It appears that present suit is filed for partition and separate possession. The present case is pending for evidence. It appears that, the plaintiff has not taken effective steps to proceed further with the suit. Record shows that, the plaintiff is absent since long. This suit is near about three years old and pending without progress. Hence, this Court has passed order below Exh.1 on 11/10/2024 and kept this suit for dismissal order. Despite of that, the plaintiff has not taken efforts to come before the Court and proceed further with this suit. Today also the plaintiff is absent till 5.30 p.m. He has not taken steps to lead evidence and proceed further with this suit. All these facts shows that, the plaintiff is not interested to proceed further. Today no any application for adjournment is filed by or on behalf of the plaintiff.

All above facts of this suit reveals that the plaintiff has lost his interest to proceed with the case. Hence, in such circumstances it is not justifiable to keep the present case pending on for further period. Hence, I pass following order.-
