ORDER

The accused is charged with offence punishable u/s. 283 of the Indian Penal Code. He appeared in person. The particulars of the offence are read over and explained to him. He voluntarily pleaded guilty. I have explained him the consequences of pleading guilty to the alleged offence. Still he pleads guilty to the offence. It appears that the accused voluntarily pleads guilty to the offence.

The accused pleaded guilty to the offence, therefore, I heard the accused on the point of sentence. He submits that he is sole bread winner of his family and this is his first offence. He

prayed for leniency.

Considering the above said discussion, the following sentence will meet the ends of justice. Hence, I pass the following order;

ORDER

1. The accused is convicted for the offence punishable under Section 283 of the Indian Penal Code vide Section 252 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and he is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 200/- (Two Hundred only), in default to suffer simple imprisonment for 5 days.
