01. Being aggrieved by the Judgment dtd. 05.02.2020, passed in P.W.D.V.A. Application No. 06/2018, the appellants preferred this Appeal. They contended that Ld. Trial Court wrongly considered the document (Exhibit 21) and granted maintenance to the respondent. As such, on the basis thereof, the Ld. Trial Court held monthly income of appellant No. 1 at Rs. 78,469/-, which is disputed by the appellants. However, somehow, the said document is not forthcoming on record. Today, Ld. Advocates for both the sides are present before the Court. On verification of the record, they fairly conceded this fact.
