SEPARATE ORDER UNDER AWARD

(Passed on this 9th day of May 2026)

The claimants No.1,4 & 5 and their learned Counsel Shri S.J.Deshmukh are present. Claimant No.1 is appearing on behalf of claimants No.2 and 3 being minors. She has filed affidavit [Exh.31] to that effect. Learned Counsel of claimants has filed certificate [Exh.32] in that regard. The opponent No.2 Insurance Company has given authority letter [Exh.35] in favour of Advocate Shri Pravin Suradkar to settle the matter. Under terms of joint pursis [Exh.36] compromise has been arrived at amongst the parties. In view of the joint pursis [Exh.36], matter has been settled at an amount of Rs.23,00,000/- to be paid by opponent No.2 to the claimants towards full and final settlement of the claim inclusive of N.F.L. amount, interest and costs. Opponent No.2 to deposit the amount within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of the order. Hence, the following order.

ORDER

- 1] Claim is disposed off in terms of joint pursis [Exh.36] and award [Exh.37].

- 2] Opponent No.2 Insurance Company is directed to deposit the amount of **Rs. 23,00,000/- (Rs. Twenty Three Lakh Only)** so as to pay it to the claimants towards full and final settlement of the claim inclusive of N.F.L. amount, medical bills, interest and costs.
- 3] The compensation amount be apportioned amongst the claimants, invested and paid to them as notified below-

Claimant	Apportionment	Manner of investment and payment
Claimant No.1	Rs.6,00,000/-	The entire amount be paid to her by directly crediting it in her bank account by e-payment mode.
Claimant No.1	Rs.1,00,000/-	The entire amount be invested in fixed deposit in her name in any Nationalized Bank of her choice for the period of three years.
Claimant No.2	Rs.5,00,000/-	The entire amount be invested in fixed deposit in her name in any Nationalized Bank of the choice of claimant No.1 till attaining of majority.
Claimant No.3	Rs.5,00,000/-	The entire amount be invested in fixed deposit in her name in any Nationalized Bank of the choice of claimant No.1 till attaining of majority.
Claimant No.4	Rs.2,50,000/-	The entire amount be paid to him by directly crediting it in his bank account by e-payment mode.
Claimant No.4	Rs.50,000/-	The entire amount be invested in fixed deposit in his name in any Nationalized Bank of his

		choice for the period of three years.
Claimant No.5	Rs.2,50,000/-	The entire amount be paid to her by directly crediting it in her bank account by e-payment mode.
Claimant No.5	Rs.50,000/-	The entire amount be invested in fixed deposit in her name in any Nationalized Bank of her choice for the period of three years.

- 4] The opponent No.2 shall deposit aforesaid amount of compensation along with interest thereon, if any, in the following Official Bank Account of the Member, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Buldhana by e-payment mode;

- 5] Opponent No.2 shall deposit the amount as aforesaid within a period of 45 days from date of receipt of the order. Failing which, the claimants are entitled to receive the aforesaid amount with an interest of 6% per annum from the date of order.
- 6] The claim against opponent No.1 is absolved against opponent No.2 Insurance Company. Hence, claim against opponent No.1 stands disposed off.

- 7] The refund of court fees, if any, be made as per the rules prevalent.
- 8] Award be drawn up accordingly.
