

**Sunanda -Vs- M.S.R.T.C**

**ORDER BELOW EXH. 05**  
**(Passed on:-03 rd day of March, 2020)**

01. This application is filed for interim compensation under section 140 of the Motor Vehicles Act.
02. Learned advocate for the claimant submitted that first information report, crime details form clearly indicate that on 03-04-2018 the claimant met with an accident involving offending vehicle. He submitted that permanent disablement certificate is also placed on record. Moreover, treatment papers have also been placed on record. Thus, interim compensation as prayed be granted.
03. As against this, learned advocate for the respondent submitted that husband of the applicant was seriously injured. Although the applicant was with him, she did not suffer any injury. In medical bills, only surname has been mentioned. Same is the case with some prescriptions. There is no fracture. The injured was admitted only for one day. Moreover, statement of husband of the claimant is placed on record vide list of documents (exhibit no. 13) which shows that the claimant did not suffer from any visible injury.
04. Although it is established that the claimant sustained injury in vehicular accident, she did not receive any fracture. Moreover, she was hospitalized only for a day. That apart,

statement of Gajanan who is her husband make its clear that she has not received any visible injury. Even PDC certificate simply points, out that there was injury. There is nothing to show that injuries led to permanent disablement in hand written portion in PDC certificate. For these reasons, I am of the view that it is not proved that the injured suffered permanent disablement. Consequently, I pass following order:-

**-ORDER-**

1. Application (Exhibit No.5) is rejected.
