This is an application filed by opponent No.2 for setting aside no written statement order and for permission to file written statement on record.

2. According to applicant/opponent No.2, in the present matter, initially the copy of written statement sent by the company is misplaced in transit. So also, thereafter, due to transfer of the legal manager, the written statement could not be filed within time. It is further submitted that, along with present application opponent No.2 had submitted written statement. It is also submitted that, if the no written statement order is not set aside, opponent No.2 will suffer from irreparable loss. Hence, prayed for setting aside the no written statement order and permission to file the written statement.
