**ORDER BELOW EXH. 1 IN REG. CRI. BAIL APPLICATION No. 90/2026**  
**Ratnapal Raju Gawai V/s. The State of Maharashtra**  
**( Passed on 11.3.2026 )**

1] Present application has been filed by the applicant/accused namely **Ratnapal Raju Gawai** under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of regular bail, in Crime No.104/2026 registered at Police Station Shegaon City, Tq.Shegaon, Dist.Buldhana for the offence punishable under Sections 75, 78, 126, 352, 351(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2] Investigating officer and learned APP Mr.PT. Lahudkar have resisted the application by filing say at Exh.6. It is contended that if accused released on bail then he will pressurize the complainant and witnesses and commit the similar offence. Accused and complainant are from different community therefore, if he released on bail then the question of law and order will be arise. Hence, they requested to reject the application.

3] The original complainant/victim appeared through learned advocate Mr. K.R. Deshmukh and filed her objection petition vide Exh.9 in the line of FIR and say of investigating officer. Hence, requested to reject the application.

4] Mr. K.J.Chopde learned advocate for applicant/accused has submitted that applicant is arrested on 26.2.2026 and since then he is behind the bar. Nothing has to recover from the applicant. He further submitted that the applicant is ready to co operate the Investigating officer in investigation. He is ready to abide each and every condition imposed, if he released on bail. Hence, he urged that considering the ground of application accused may be released on bail.

5] Learned APP Mr.PT. Lahudkar, has argued as per the say Exh.5 and urged to reject the application.

6] Learned advocate Mr. K.R.Deshmukh, for original complainant/victim has argued at length in line of protest petition Exh.9 and urged to reject the application.

7] I have thoughtfully considered the submission of both sides. Perused the application, say filed by the I.O., APP as well as original complainant. I have perused the documents placed on record by the applicant/accused as well as the police papers and case diary.

8] As per contents of FIR, complainant is a 19 years young girl who lodged the report at police station Shegaon City against the accused. It is alleged that she is taking education of B.Com. 2<sup>nd</sup> year at Shegaon. She was having visiting terms to the house of her friend Neha Raju Tayade. Accused also used to come to the house of Neha Tayade. Therefore, accused got acquainted with her. He took her mobile number. It is alleged that after some days when she was in the house of her friend, at that time accused along with his 2-3 friends came there.

They told that they will bring the breakfast and went away. Thereafter, he brought the breakfast. As she was having fast of Thursday hence, she did not take the breakfast. He taken her selfie with her friend. He also taken selfie with the complainant. It is alleged that when she was going to college, accused used to talk with her forcibly and she was avoiding to talk with him. However, accused was trying to chase her. It is alleged that on 16.2.2026 at about 11.00 a.m. she was going to the house from the college by walk at that time accused chased her and restrained her way by his vehicle near the Saptshringi Mata Temple. He told that he is having love with complainant and he wanted to marry with her. He threatened to stop the education of her sister if she did not talk with him. He threatened to defame her by editing her selfie photographs. He outraged her modesty. It is alleged that on 24.2.2026 at about 2.30 p.m. she along with her sister were present at her house at that time accused came in front of her house shouted loudly and abused her. When her mother came outside the house, he was armed with glass bottle and asked her mother to came down otherwise, he will enter in the house. He threatened that if complainant not marry with him, then he will not allow her marriage with anybody and he will threw acid on her face and kill her.

9] The police papers shows that applicant/accused arrested on 26.2.2026 and since then he is behind the bar. The investigation is near about completed. Hence, his further custody is not necessary. Therefore, no purpose would be served keeping the applicant behind bar. He is ready to co-operate the police in investigation and abide each and every condition imposed, if he released on bail. Therefore, though the prosecution has resisted the application, but if

applicant/accused released on bail on certain conditions, then prosecution will not be prejudiced. Hence, application deserves to be allowed. In result, I pass the following order :-

**ORDER**

(1)	Application Exh.1 is allowed.
(2)	Applicants/accused <b>Ratnapal Raju Gawai</b> , shall be released on bail in connection with Crime No.104/2026 registered at Police Station Shegaon City, Tq.Shegaon, Dist.Buldhana for the offence punishable under Sections 75, 78, 126, 352, 351(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, on executing PR bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand only) and surety bond in like amount.
(3)	He shall appear before the investigating officer at concerned Police Station on every Saturday and Monday between 2 p.m.to 5 p.m. till filing final report.
(4)	He shall not enter in the Shegaon City and Shegaon Taluka, until further order, except the attendance at police station.
(5)	He shall not pressurize the complainant and prosecution witnesses from deposing before the Court.
(6)	On breach of condition of bail order, prosecution will be liberty to apply for cancellation of bail.
(7)	Bail before concerned JMFC Court.
